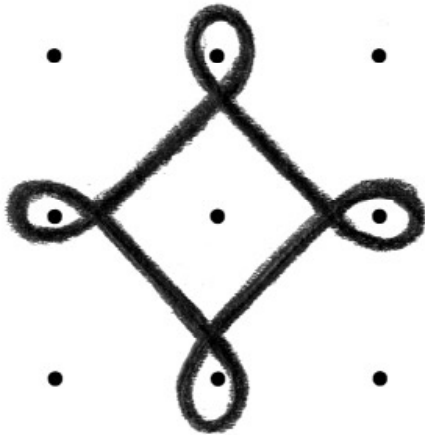

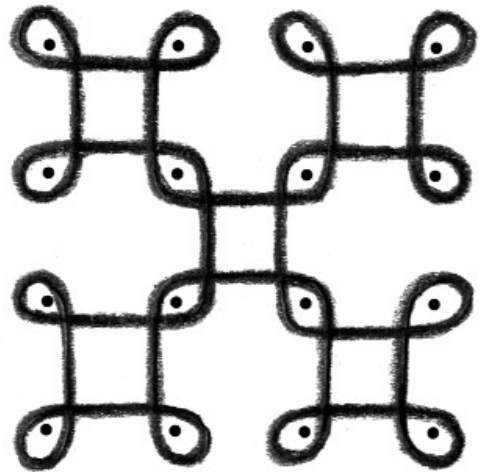

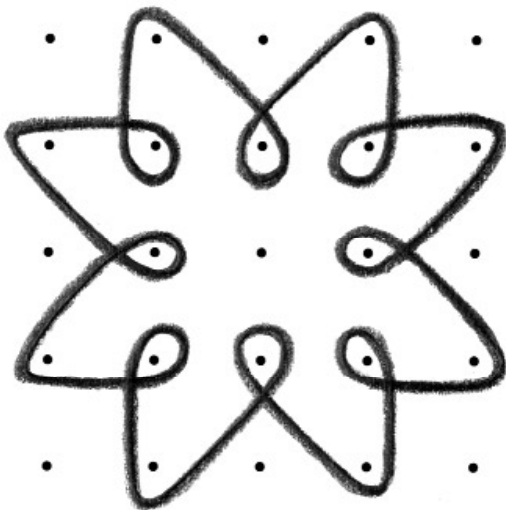

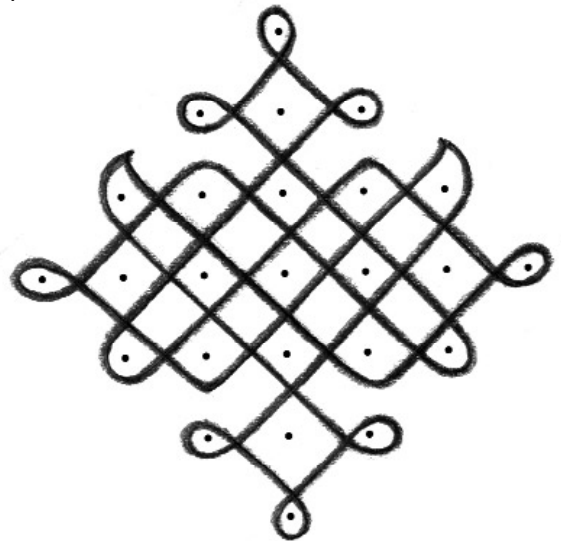


Fig. 1: (3 lines; 3 dots)
